

Integrated Community Ministries, Inc. (ICM's) Bunkhouse Rules and Safety Guidelines

Welcome to ICMs Bunkhouse. We hope you will have a safe and enjoyable stay with us. On your first day please do not arrive at the bunkhouse until after 2pm unless other arrangements have been made in advance. On the your day of departure please plan to leave by 11am.

Bring with you: Your own sleeping bag or sheets and blanket, pillow, hygiene items and towel(s). Please bring a flashlight, bug spray, and sunscreen.

No smoking anywhere in the building or on worksites. No alcoholic beverages. No drugs. No pets. No firearms, no fireworks, no explosives.

Fire risk: no cooking with flamed appliances or BBQ's inside the bunkhouse. No naked flames allowed at all in the bunkhouse, so no candles, no using a cigarette lighter, no paraffin lamps.

Fire: if a fire should break out press the fire alarm and leave the bunkhouse immediately. Once out of the bunkhouse call 911 and assemble by the trash box by the trees.

Fire alarm: if the fire alarm sounds at any time leave the bunkhouse at once.

Behavior: We expect all visitors to comply with our regulations, and to show respect for other users of the site, our staff, our neighbors and the land. Where the site rules are not respected we reserve the right to refuse admission and/or ask all members of a group to leave the site at any time.

No groups under the age of 18 will be accepted unless accompanied by an appropriate number of responsible adults.

Please observe quiet time between 10 pm and 6 am.

Any person or group that breaks any of the rules or causes any damage will be asked to leave and will be charged accordingly. **No money** will be refunded if you are asked to leave.

Lost/left property: will be kept on the premises for a period of 2 weeks. Unless claimed and reunited in this time, it will be donated to the thrift shop. If you think you may have left something here email us as soon as possible and, we will check for you, and then we can arrange the items return.

We accept no liability for anyone getting hurt or injured, on the property or on the worksites, or in travel. We accept no liability/responsibility for loss of personal property, damage to vehicles, or any other unforeseen circumstances. We do not accept responsibility for the security of your vehicles or belongings whilst on site. Please ensure that all valuables are properly secured at all times.

Cleaning: Please leave the bunkhouse as you find it. Please wash any dishes, etc that you use and put them back in the cupboards or on the shelf they came from. Please clean up after yourself. Vacuum the carpets and sweep the floors. All trash containers should be emptied prior to your leaving.
